## **Supporting partners in Brazil**

The Pavement Project team in Brazil work with partner churches and organisations to reach young people with God's message of healing and hope. Cleisse Andrade updates us on recent news:

"One of the activities planned for this year is in-person visits to partners ... In March, we visited the team at Casa Semente (Seed House), located in Duque de Caxias on the outskirts of Rio de Janeiro. This organisation is in an area with a high risk of violence and confrontations with the police. It is participating in Kid Talk (a programme that helps children address issues of loss and grief) and the children have been opening up about the memories of the losses they have suffered. The visit strengthened the partnership, valued the team for the hard work they do, and proposed training for a new volunteer to provide counselling with Pavement Project resources."

### **Daily Strength**

Anne-Louise, who works as a chaplain with older people, shares her experience of *Daily Strength* and the encouragement that this resource has brought to those she supports:

"As a chaplain, I often use *Daily Strength* with the individuals that I support because I find that it is so well received. On one occasion, I had been visiting a Christian who had been a professional academic and who had suffered a stroke in his 60s. He used to get upset about the way he could no longer read long passages of Scripture, and he found concentration in general very difficult

... then he [showed me] *Daily Strength*. 'This is wonderful,' he said. 'It's such a help to me because I can't read my Bible very much now.'

"After an end of year service at a sheltered housing centre, I gave a copy of *Daily Strength* to each person who had attended. As one lady was leaving the room ... she said to me, 'And where is the little present you gave me?' She wanted to make sure that she was taking it away with her because she saw it as a gift. I knew it would be valued, because it is so beautifully produced and illustrated. As many people reach an older age, they want to know more about God but don't know how to go about it. This booklet opens them up to the power of God's Word, and as they talk to God, or someone else prays with them or for them, they are open to having a relationship with God."

#### **Training in Indonesia**

A key part of Lifewords work in Indonesia is training people how to use Lifewords resources and to reach out to their communities. Gunar Sahari, Lifewords Indonesia Director, shares some recent news:

"Training pastors in East Kalimantan is a regular monthly activity aimed at providing continuous guidance and support for pastors. This programme helps pastors grow in their ministry, equipping them to advance in their service, and further develop and expand their work for the Lord. It is an opportunity for pastors to be strengthened and inspired to continue spreading God's Word and serving their communities.

"We also train seminary students, with a focus on learning how to share the gospel by first building relationships. Students are taught the importance of getting to know others before sharing their faith. This approach helps them connect with people in a meaningful way and makes the sharing of the gospel more effective. The training emphasises building trust and understanding as a foundation for spreading God's message."
