Believe the Women

Happy Easter! As we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus and reflect on the events of Easter week, we are reminded of the moment when the women discovered that the tomb was empty and that Jesus was alive.

Our resource, *Day Three: Believe the Women* helps us think about the Easter story through the experiences of the women who were there. "They ... tell us something important about the story on which the whole hope of the Bible narrative hangs: the resurrection," says Danielle Welch, writing on the Lifewords blog. "With courage [the women] stay at the cross when everyone else flees. Risking their own safety they follow Jesus' body to burial. And at the break of dawn, they become the first witnesses to the extraordinary truth that Jesus has risen from the dead. They are terrified, confused and not believed. The single most important moment in human history is announced by women whose culture could not hear them. We are reminded that the Kingdom of God is radically good news, subverting our idea of who and what matters."

Life Changing Words (LCW) invites us to make room for a verse from the Bible every day, and to put the words we read into practice. Users sign-up to receive a verse a day to their email inbox or mobile device. They can read, respond, and share the verses that they read, and join the rest of the LCW community as it engages with the Bible.

Last year, LCW released a new version of the app and since then has seen more and more people using it. "In February of this year, we recorded over 9,000 new installations of the app," says Jarek Jankowski, Global Bible Resources Director. "Last year, after the launch of the new app, the average monthly number of installations jumped from 1,300 to 6,000, which was a phenomenal result. The first two months of 2024 have been even better! We hope the trend will continue."

After being used successfully in Brazil, "Elige la Vida" (Choose Life) has been launched for 71 partners in the 13 Spanish-speaking countries where Pavement Project operates. Choose Life is a curriculum for young people aged 9 to 14, with interactive lessons that teach about choices and consequences. The programme helps them make their own decisions based on biblical values of love, peace, justice, freedom, and consideration for others.

"After eight months of planning, translation, review, web configurations, and recording of an instructional video, Choose Life has reached the partners and will soon reach the children," says Cleisse Andrade from Lifewords in Latin America. "We are excited about the potential of Choose Life to change lives."
