To further reach a broader audience, the Little Brick of Little Books provides a boxed collection of the Little Books to equip ministries in making a wider impact across schools, churches, prisons, youth groups, debt centres, hospital chaplaincies, and more. The Little Brick of Little Books features seven copies of each of the seven titles, 49 Little Books in total.

Like all Lifewords resources, Little Book of Advent is freely available, but donations are both appreciated and encouraged. The brick box-set is available for a minimum £25 donation.
